BAR BAILEY was boxed in between horses early, got through four wide on the turn, rallied in the lane, lugged in making her bid nearing the sixteenth marker, got a narrow advantage under a stern drive shortly after that and held on. SAVORTHETIME stalked the early speed from inside, was boxed in through the turn, got through two wide leaving the bend, moved clear in the upper stretch, was engaged by BAR BAILEY nearing the final sixteenth, tried hard but had to settle for second best. ELEGANT MERCEDES was altered inside SANDIA'S FLICKA after leaving the chute, settled just off the rail, swung five wide for room on the turn and passed tired ones from outside through the stretch. YET ANOTHERNATALIE stumbled at the start, quickly recovered to vie for the lead outside SANDIA'S FLICKA going to the turn, moved clear on the bend, stayed in path three leaving the turn and gradually wore down between horses. SANDIA'S FLICKA drifted out as she moved clear for the early lead, was soon corrected and brought back toward the inside, set a pressured pace just off the rail, lost the lead on the turn and flattened out through the lane. SEXY BOOTS was prominent early between rivals but gave way two wide on the turn. DEVIL DANCING raced in contention from outside on the backstretch but faded four wide on the bend.
