**Footnotes**

DESERT GAMBLE trailed from outside, gradually progressed on the backstretch, three wide into the second turn, fanned to path five entering the lane, was all out and got up in time. DOUBLE SMART in the second flight along the rail, came off the inside some entering the second bend, waited for room, got through three wide into the stretch, closed well between horses, was outfinished but gained second near the wire. RUNNIN RED shared the lead just outside CINPLY DONE, moved clear when allowed on the second turn, was all out in the stretch and gradually wore down in the late going. TRAIN RIDER BLUES in contention four wide, did not keep up while three wide on the second turn, fanned out some into the lane and found best stride too late. SOME GHOST was settled just off the inside, gradually made up ground going to the second turn and closed belatedly just off the rail deep stretch. CIMPLY DONE showed first, contested the pace just off or along the rail, could not stay with RUNNING RED on the second turn and flattened out the last quarter mile.
