Footnotes

RED TAPPER four wide on the first bend, was rated from outside, went for the lead six wide on the second turn, angled in as those inside him came in leaving that bend, gradually angled in after taking the advantage upper stretch and moved clear seventy yards out. PROSPECT FOR TERRA settled early, made his move between rivals, just inside RED TAPPER, on the second turn, battled that one in the stretch, did not have enough left inside the last sixteenth and was altered out nearing the wire. SWITHIN rated well off the top pair, gained a slight advantage three wide on the second turn, took the rail leaving that bend, was no match for the top pair the last furlong but unchallenged for the show. SQUATTY BOB also settled early, closed the gap just off the inside on the second bend, fanned out some for the stretch run and improved position without threatening. DOUBLE ENUFF rated in midpack came into contention four wide on the second turn, also came in leaving the turn, advanced just off the inside upper stretch then leveled off. TRIPLE STAR hesitated at the break, spotting the field a couple lengths, progressed between horses on the second turn, took the rail in the lane, passed tired ones upper stretch then finished evenly. PHONE CHOPIN chased from between horses, was caught in tight quarters two wide midway on the second turn, gained more room as he swung out some into the stretch but had little to offer. TURKOMAN PETE well off the inside nearly all the way, showed little. CALL ME LUKE disputed the pace just outside OURHORSEWITHNONAME but faltered on the second turn. OURHORSEWITHNONAME vied for the lead from inside but faltered on the second bend.
