Footnotes

HEARING VOICES away slowly, advanced between horses, had the advantage three wide on the turn, was clear into the lane and held sway under a mild drive. THREEGOODKIDS without early speed, though urged along, was four to six wide taking the bend, steadily closed the gap in the stretch and gained second. SILENT SUNDAY prominent between horses from the beginning, threatened four wide on the turn but hung in the stretch. BOLIVAR SHAG disputed the pace from inside, could not stay with HEARING VOICES while just off the inside in the stretch and slowly yielded inside the last eighth. BLAZEN L came into contention along the rail on the turn, fanned out some for the stretch run, altered out five wide for a clear path midstretch and improved position in the late going without gaining more ground. SANTO BUENO broke slowly and inward, was three wide on the bend, altered to the rail upper stretch for room, progressed to the final furlong then leveled off. MCKENNA BOY dropped well back shortly after the break, stayed wide throughout and passed tired ones in the stretch. FLASHY RED ODD'S forwardly placed between rivals, was three to five wide taking the bend, tired in the lane and gradually drifted out the last furlong. KAWANA BAND void of speed, was four wide on the turn, lost further ground fanning to path seven entering the stretch and had no late bid. HIGH SIETE moved to the inside nearing the turn and came up empty for the drive. HONOR EXPRESS hustled along to contest the pace between horses, gave way just off the inside leaving the turn, drifted out into the stretch and continued to fade.
