Footnotes

DUMPSEY JEAN in contention between rivals from the beginning, angled in on the turn, waited for a clear path upper stretch, got through along the rail just inside the furlong marker, was clear with seventy yards left and held APT BAND at bay under a stern drive. APT BAND without early foot between horses, picked up her pace from path three on the turn, was blocked into the lane, altered out five wide leaving the three-sixteenths marker, lugged in some inside the final sixteenth, was corrected, closed well and was getting to DUMPSEY JEAN nearing the wire. TIME FOR DECEPTION away slowly, was void of speed though hustled along, angled out on the turn, lost considerable ground fanning eight wide entering the stretch, made a strong move and caught RUBY BEAN for third in the waning yards. RUBY BEAN contested the pace just off or along the rail, was all out two wide the last eighth but did not have enough left. SASSY PROSPECTOR showed first, vied for the lead just outside RUBY BEAN, fought gamely in the stretch, slowly yielded nearing the final sixteenth, fell past the wire and was vanned off. DANCEFORJONESZIE in midpack from outside, lost ground five then six wide through the turn and gradually made up ground in the stretch. IDEAL MISS broke outward and was steadied, had no early speed while not far off the inside, swung out on the bend, was seven wide entering the lane and steadily closed the gap. ALARMING LADY an early factor between horses, backed up some while four wide on the turn, fanned out some for the drive and lacked a significant response. SLEWFULS STAR disputed the pace from outside, three and four wide taking the bend then weakened did not have enough left for the stretch run. SPECIAL EGO hustled along to be prominent from inside, waited for room just off the rail behind the leaders on the turn, angled three wide for the drive and wore down the last eighth. MOVING SPIRIT without speed toward the outside, was four

and five wide taking the turn, found herself behind ALARMING LADY at the head of the lane, altered in upper stretch but lacked a rally. LA MARIPOSA hesitated at the start, advanced between rivals, moved to the rail into the turn and failed to have a stretch bid.
