BRASSY PETE was never far back, raced wide through the turn, responded to steady handling and wore down TRAVIS WEAVER in the final yards. TRAVIS WEAVER was away alertly to press the pace from the outside, moved up to take a slight edge nearing the five-sixteenths pole and gave way grudgingly in the drive. THE GREY SAINT raced off the pacesetters from the inside, responded to steady urging late and finished with good energy. OILFIELD TRASH was off slow and bobbed, raced wide through the turn and finished with a steady bid. CURRENTLY KRAZY set a pressured pace from the inside and gave way through the final furlong. COMMANDER CODY raced off the leaders early, moved up to offer a bid from the far outside nearing the quarter and gave way in the drive. INDIAN SPIRIT pressed the pace from between foes for the opening quarter and weakened. ONE QUICK BUDDY showed brief speed, raced far wide through the turn and weakened. DRAMATIC KING was away alertly, dropped back quickly and was not a factor.
