Footnotes

GINGER'S SON pressed from between horses, was three wide through the bend, put to a drive leaving the turn, gained a narrow advantage nearing the sixteenth marker then slowly edged ahead under steady handling. PRINCE OF ROGUES broke in stride, duelled for the lead between horses, moved ahead two wide on the turn, was all out in the lane, did not have enough in the waning yards but was easily best of the others. MINT MOHITO bumped with BERNARDO STAR after the break, was forced out after leaving the chute, bumped hard with LIFTED TRICK, was checked, also took the turn three wide, took over third upper stretch then could only pull clear for that position late. GUANTANAMO BAY KID angled out as STUCK IN LODI came out entering the main track, moved inside that one after travelling a sixteenth of a mile, was prominent along the rail on the bend, swung out to path four entering the lane and lacked a significant response. DEVON'S PRINCE without speed from between horses, progressed just off the inside on the turn, fanned out four wide into the stretch, altered out for room nearing the eighth pole and steadily advanced without threatening. STUCK IN LODI gradually drifted out as he left the chute, vied for the lead inside PRINCE OF ROGUES, had the rail on the turn, came off the inside some for the stretch run and flattened. ST HOPE without speed from outside, backed up four wide on the turn, swung out to the middle of the track for the drive and gradually improved position. LIFTED TRICK broke inward, jostled with MESQUITEER, was bumped hard and forced out shortly after entering the main track, had the rail on the bend and passed tired ones from inside through the lane. RIVER JONES in contention early, was three wide on the bend, drifted out into the stretch and faded. BERNARDO STAR bumped with MINT MOHITO after the start, altered out as GUANTANAMO BAY KID came out after leaving the chute, improved position two wide on the turn but gave way through the lane. DONTKISSDAPREACHER also jostled about at the break, ran in midpack on the backstretch, was four to six wide

taking the bend, lacked a stretch bid and angled inside RIVER JONES inside the final eighth. MESQUITEER jostled about between rivals at the start, was checked, taken to the far outside and showed little. There was a stewards' inquiry into the early portion of the race but no action taken after their review.
