**Footnotes**

YOUAREFUN rated from outside, picked up his pace five wide on the turn, fanned out further for a clear path leaving the bend, gradually lugged in as he rallied under a drive, had the advantage inside the final furlong and shook off VINNY V. with seventy yards left. VINNY V. advanced quickly to contest the pace just outside BONGO STRAITS, moved ahead on the turn, stayed just off the rail, was challenged upper stretch, tried hard, did not have enough left in the waning yards but moved clear for the place. SOUTHERN SAVVY in midpack between horses on the backstretch, angled in to be just off the inside on the turn, bumped with BONGO STRAITS nearing the quarter pole, gained the inside entering the lane, threatened with a furlong left but leveled off instead and narrowly held third. THREE SLEWS forwardly placed outside from the beginning, closed the gap while staying five wide on the turn and failed to have the necessary late bid. AWESOME LAUNCH turned his head just as the gate opened, spotting the field a couple lengths, rushed up just off the inside, was three wide on the turn, failed to keep up leaving the bend, angled in some, still had a striking position midstretch, angled out four wide inside the last eight and slowly yielded. SHAKIN N DANCIN in the second flight between rivals, made his bid for the lead four wide on the bend but wore down through the lane. BONGO STRAITS moved up from inside to dispute the pace, began to retreat along the rail on the turn, bumped with SOUTHERN SAVVY approaching the quarter pole, was checked as he tried to drift out near that marker, floated out when clear shortly after that and had little left. IN BROAD DAYLIGHT stumbled just after the break, was then checked behind traffic, altered to the outside, was just off the inside entering the turn, drifted out widest of all into the lane and was empty.
