Footnotes

ISN'T HE CLEVER stalked the early speed from path four, went for the lead when let out three wide on the second turn, floated out some with the advantage into the lane, moved clear under a drive and held off ZACKN'MAT under steady handling. ZACKN'MAT settled, angled out on the first turn, picked up his pace just off the inside on the second bend, swung out behind ISN'T HE CLEVER entering the stretch, angled outside that one approaching the last furlong, steadily closed the gap, came up short but was easily second best. MAJOR HOPE bumped at the start, raced in contention just off the inside, took the rail on the second turn, altered outside SO FAR SO FAST midstretch and got third nearing the wire. SO FAR SO FAST soon had the lead, was challenged while just off the inside on the backstretch, took the rail on the second bend, was no match for the top pair when set down for the drive and slowly wore down inside the final furlong. TEQUILA FACTOR advanced between horses to vie for the lead just outside SO FAR SO FAST, began to retreat leaving the second turn, floated out some entering the lane, battled for third deep stretch but was outfinished. JUSTANOLDSONG broke outward, bumping MAJOR HOPE, raced in contention from outside, was three then four wide through the second turn, began to fade, angled out widest midstretch and finished evenly. STRONG RESOLVE soon backed up from between horses, moved to the rail near the half mile marker and steadily gave way.
