Footnotes

FAST A NUFF caught in tight quarters leaving the chute, bumped with LESS ODDS, was settled, picked up his pace three wide on the turn, altered out some at the top of the lane, split rivals, rallied and got up in time. FRED'S HENNESSY prominent toward the outside, commenced his bid three wide on the turn, angled in some upper stretch, gained a narrow advantage inside the final furlong, was all out but had to settle for second best. CAHONE CREEK also bumped with LESS ODDS shortly after the break, soon had the lead between horses, took the rail into the bend, floated out some leaving the turn, moved back to the rail upper stretch, fought gamely but did not have enough left the last sixteenth. FULL OF PRIDE forwardly placed outside, lost ground four then five wide taking the bend and found best stride too late deep stretch. EGO AND HONOR fractious behind the gate, bumped with SUPER CHAMP shortly after the start, was an early factor from outside, followed FULL OF PRIDE on the turn, lost further ground fanning outside that one into the lane, closed well but came up short. SUPER CHAMP bumped with EGO AND HONOR leaving the chute, waited for room behind traffic on the backstretch, advanced along the rail on the turn but could not sustain his bid in the stretch. STONE COLD ODDS chased from along or just off the inside, swung out three wide on the

bend, altered out to path six looking for room upper stretch and gradually improved position without threatening. LESS ODDS squeezed back shortly after the start, lost position four wide on the turn, fanned out leaving the bend, drifted out to the middle of the track into the lane and passed some tired ones. MILLER WHO pressed the early speed from just outside but flattened out for the drive. LIVE AMMO gradually backed up from along or just off the rail, angled out five wide at the top of the stretch and had little left. FORT STANTON LAD soon trailed, stayed in paths three or four, lugged in upper stretch and had no late bid.
