INTHENICKOFTIME set the early pace drawing clear, was never challenged and opened up in the stretch. RIVER ECHO was within striking distance early saving ground placed a bid in the stretch but was no match and followed the winner through the stretch. GENTSFINISHFIRST stalked the early leaders off the inside and lacked a closing effort. HEAR NO ANGEL was outrun early, went four wide to rally and showed some interest late. METALLIC MIST forced the early pace three wide and was finished after a half. ROARIN' BAYOU was unhurried early, went five wide and lacked a bid. WESTERN PINE went five wide and faded steadily. SUMMER SURPRISE dropped back to trail the field racing wide and failed to menace.
