Footnotes

FOGGY HAZE floated out some entering the first turn, showed the way from paths two or three, was roused on the second bend then gradually opened up under steady handling. RED ALARM was a step slow at the break then bumped with VANEFUHR, was settled, gradually progressed three or four wide, was forced in after entering the final furlong but got up for second in the waning yards. OUR STORM, whose rider did not carry a whip, was bumped at the break, caught five wide on the first bend, pressed the pacesetter while toward the outside on the backstretch, four wide taking the second turn and found best stride too late the last eighth. GO GENTRY pressed FOGGY HAZE from just outside, drifted out to path five entering the lane, lugged in after entering the final furlong and lost position. WEDNESDAYAFTERNOON raced in contention close to the inside, moved to the rail leaving the quarter pole, took over second upper stretch but weakened in the late going. VANEFUHR bobbed at the break then bumped RED ALARM, was settled between horses, saved ground on the second turn, came off the inside some for a clear path entering the stretch, closed the gap some going to the eighth pole then finished evenly. STAR FIX broke outward, bumping OUR STORM, was settled inside, came off the rail some into the second bend, fanned out to path five into the lane and passed tired ones. TRIPP TO GLORY a contender from outside for nearly a half mile, failed to stay close widest through the second turn and had no late bid. ITSALLINTHE TIMING was prominent from inside for six furlongs, checked when her path was taken leaving the second turn then steadily gave way.
