Footnotes

PUP forwardly placed between horses, was blocked nearing the turn, angled in some entering the bend, made up ground just off the inside, fanned four wide for the stretch run, rallied to gain the advantage with a sixteenth to go and held on. GALLERY OF STORMS prominent from inside, swung out for room on the turn, came into the stretch from path five, battled gamely on the front end but could not get past PUP in the waning yards. BUBBA WHO broke in stride, was engaged from inside before finishing the first furlong, two wide on the turn, floated out some entering the stretch, tried hard to hold on between rivals but did not have enough left in the waning yards. KINGDOM HEART soon challenged for the lead just off the inside, gained the rail into the turn and slowly wore down the final eighth. COOL HAND WIT forced in some at the break, advanced from inside, also angled out looking for a clear path on the turn, found himself behind GALLERY OF STORMS at the top of the stretch, altered outside that one inside the last furlong but could not close the gap. DISTINCT LUCK trailed from between horses, was steadied behind traffic into the turn, altered in, soon came off the rail to gain a clear path, altered in again to gain room entering the stretch then steadily advanced without threatening. SILVERS LEADER displayed early speed between rivals, was steadied briefly nearing the half mile marker when his path narrowed, three wide on the bend, drifted out to path six into the lane and gradually faded. WHAT'S THE RUMPUS was taken to the outside early trying to gain a clear path, four to six wide through the bend, was blocked behind SILVERS LEADER at the head of the lane,

altered in to be four wide nearing the eighth pole and had no late bid. PARADE DRESS was a contender from outside on the backstretch but began to tire three wide leaving the turn. MACKENZIE'SDELIGHT also forced in briefly at the start, was taken outside looking for room midway on the backstretch, was widest taking the turn and had no stretch bid. SPELL CASINO broke inward, was a brief factor just off the inside, checked behind traffic entering the bend, moved to the rail nearing the quarter pole and continued to give way. SALTY SIR prominent between horses early, began to back up in close quarters nearing the turn, was checked and appeared to clip SPELL CASINO'S heels nearing the three-furlong marker, faded, was eased and walked off.
