Footnotes

SEVENTYNINE advanced three wide on the backstretch, was put to a drive four wide on the second turn, fanned out further entering the lane, gradually altered out to stay clear of LAWTON'S BREEZE deep stretch and edged ahead nearing the wire. LAWTON'S BREEZE bumped with UNTOUCHABLE TODD at the break, moved up just outside that one to share the lead on the backstretch, took over from path three on the second turn, was clear leaving that bend, gradually drifted out the last eighth, was outfinished but easily second best. ORPHAN THUNDER prominent from path three or four, followed LAWTON'S BREEZE on the second turn, altered in some for a clear path entering the lane, gradually gained the rail, was no match for the top pair and narrowly lasted for the show. FIRST CLASSNTHESKY without early foot from outside, angled in some as he picked up his pace into the second turn, progressed just off the rail, fanned outside SEVENTYNINE for the stretch run, lugged in after entering the final furlong and just missed for third. SHOTGUN RYDER well placed just off or along the rail, was blocked leaving the second turn, altered out to gain a clear path three wide into the stretch but had no late bid. HANGMAN'S GULCH inattentive at the break, was away slowly, trailed from inside, commenced his bid along the rail into the second turn, lost ground fanning out widest entering the lane, drifted out a bit further nearing the eighth pole and passed a few tired ones. SEA MONSTER broke inward and was steadied, advanced to the second flight from between rivals, was just off the inside entering the second turn, swung four wide for a clear path into the lane and lacked a significant response. UNTOUCHABLE TODD bumped with LAWTON'S BREEZE at the start, soon had a clear lead just off the inside, was engaged from outside on the backstretch, lost the lead on the second turn, took the rail leaving that bend and steadily gave way. CACTUS COWBOY broke outward and was checked, steadily faded from outside, stayed wide through the second turn and into the stretch, was urged along but unresponsive. YER HUCKLEBERRY a brief contender along the rail, slowly came off the inside on the backstretch as he began to fade, was eased through the stretch and walked off.
