GOLD PLATED drifted out some as she vied for the lead after the break, moved clear just off the inside on the turn, was asked at the top of the stretch then steadily opened up under a drive. QUICK IN MOTION disputed the pace three wide, could not stay with GOLD PLATED on the bend, moved clear for second inside the eighth pole then could only maintain her position late. SOONER THAN THAT was prominent between rivals early, angled in on the turn, then gradually progressed two wide and took over third the last sixteenth. AURBURN BELLE altered inside early, rushed up to vie for the lead, was checked along the rail on the turn then gradually faded. SHANNON SUE pressed toward the outside, was three then four wide taking the bend then lacked the needed stretch bid. SAPHIRA'S FLIGHT was hustled along from outside, improved position four wide on the turn, drifted out some entering the stretch and flattened. I'M ALL SHOOK UP broke slowly and outward, stayed in path four or five and failed to menace. ZEBBA was void of speed though hustled along, gradually backed up from path three and was empty for the drive. MAKEYOUROWNDREAM dwelt at the start, stayed well off the inside and always outrun. The rider of AURBURN BELLE lodged an objection alleging interference from GOLD PLATED on the turn. After their review, the stewards made no change.
