DREAM KIN stalked the early leaders from along the inside, angled out down the backstretch to gain some ground, then placed a bid between rivals at the top of the stretch and inched away to prove best late. FLYING Y L STORM moved up three wide into the first turn, set the early pace racing off the rail, was challenged nearing the five sixteenths, battled into the stretch, drifted out late and yielded. S L R LONESOMEDOVE was unhurried early angled out five wide gaining ground down the backstretch, went five wide at the top of the stretch, altered inward at the eighth pole and was up for the show. ROWDY SKIES was allowed to settle early four wide, fanned six wide at the top of the stretch, was forced out by FLYING Y L STORM thru the stretch, then altered inward nearing the wire. CHRISSIE BEGONE prompted the early pace from the inside and was finished early. PRETTY DANSEUR rallied four wide into the second turn, gained a short lead at the five sixteenth pole then gave way. RED HOT N SPICY trailed the field racing off the rail and was not a factor.
