FOUND A PENNY stalked the early leaders five wide, sustained a bid to gain a short lead at the eighth pole and edged clear. SAINT STREET was unhurried early racing three wide, drifted out six wide into the stretch and closed well. TRICK THE CAT set the early pace, opened up on the field, was challenged in the stretch, failed to last but held the show. XCESSIVE LEAD was forwardly placed early four wide, sustained a brief bid then went evenly late. ANNIE ROLL was outrun early, went six wide and showed some interest late. RED'S LASS was off slow early, went five wide and placed a mild bid. JAZZY JINGLE prompted the early pace from between foes and was finished early. BASIN ST. HEIRESS was hustled away while saving ground then faded in the stretch. GOOD NITE GRACE raced mid pack five wide then retreated steadily. MISS APACHE showed little racing wide in the stretch.
