JACKS PARTY stalked the early leaders four wide, vied in the stretch, was urged steadily and drew clear. PATRIOT JOE forced the early pace four wide, placed a bid to duel in the stretch then weakened nearing the wire. YOU FOLLOW ME set the early pace five wide, was challenged into the stretch then tired in the final furlong. SEATTLE FLASH was unhurried early, saved ground and showed some effort late to get up for the show. DANCE DERBY was allowed to settle early, went four wide and showed some interest late. ROLL WESTWARD was within striking early, sustained a bid then weakened. A J ALLIE was outrun early, went five wide and improved his position. UNCLE CLAUDE showed little in a dull effort.
