Footnotes

APRIL SPOOLS broke in stride and was hustled clear, showed the way just off the inside, floated out a bit upper stretch, kept a straight path the rest of the way, was all out and narrow held on. STEINMETZ raced in the second flight from outside, moved clear for second three wide on the bend, angled outside APRIL SPOOLS upper stretch, drifted out some inside the final furlong, was corrected, closed well and just missed. DANCE BEFOREASTORM in tight briefly after the start, was steadied in traffic nearing the end of the first furlong, altered out soon after that, advanced four wide on the bend, lost further ground fanning to the middle of the track entering the lane, lugged in some upper stretch then gradually closed the gap after taking over third inside the last eighth. LANTY'S BULL prominent between horses, was caught in tight quarters into the bend, bumped with HENNESSY'S LADY, swung four wide into the lane, lugged in midstretch, held a straight path the last eighth but weakened. IRISH DRONE in midpack early just off the inside, lodged a mild bid entering the stretch, fought briefly for third then leveled off. SLEWKAYSA trailed from outside, was four to six wide taking the bend, steadied and altered in when her path was taken inside the final furlong then continued to advance. DISCREET SNOW failed to menace in a ground-saving trip. W S SUNRISE CAT forwardly placed on the backstretch, was three to five wide taking the bend, began to tire in the lane, was angled outside DANCE BEFOREASTORM midstretch and had little left. HENNESSY'S LADY in the second flight just off the inside, was bumped and forced in entering the bend, fanned out three wide for the drive, began to fade, was angled out some midstretch for a clear path and gradually gave way. MISS MAJORETTE without speed between horses, took the turn five wide and failed to have a stretch bid. CHATTY MARIA stedly faded from between horses. DIG DIS PICTURE was soon well back, stayed off the inside through the bend and was empty in the lane.
