**Footnotes**

LIZ'S PIRATE was kept close just off the inside, had the rail on the bend, floated out some for the stretch run, rallied under a stern drive and caught TOUGH PILGRIM in the final strides. TOUGH PILGRIM prominent outside from the beginning, was four and five wide through the turn, gained a narrow advantage nearing the sixteenth marker, fought gamely but had to settle for second best. SIZZLING FARGO hesitated at the break, slowly progressed between horses, was three wide with a quarter mile to go, altered inside FAMILY GUY leaving the bend, was blocked going to the eighth pole, altered out to path five inside the final furlong, split rivals, closed strongly, lugged in some nearing the wire and was too late. STRIKINOUT N MIAMI in midpack between rivals, was just off the inside entering the turn, forced to fan six wide for a clear path into the stretch, belatedly made up ground the final furlong and was steadied near the wire as his path narrowed. NUN LIKE ME broke alertly, set a pressured pace from inside, moved ahead leaving the turn, lengthened his lead under a drive in the stretch but did not have enough left inside the last eighth. GO FOR COVER without early foot, was in path four on the turn, lost considerable ground fanning eight wide into the lane and also found best stride too late. FAMILY GUY was also void of early speed, progressed just off the inside on the bend, lost ground as well when swung seven wide for the stretch run, steadily closed the gap but outfinished by those with more left. ICED OUT well back early,

had the rail into the turn, floated out some into the stretch, altered out to path five with less than a furlong left and gradually made up ground. SEISMOMETER prominent between horses from the start, was four wide entering the lane and flattened out. INDIGO POWER displayed early speed between horses, two and three wide taking the bend then gave way for the drive. LAST GAMBLE steadily faded from outside, was pulled up on the turn and vanned off.
