Footnotes

DANCING GHOST set a pressured pace between horses, moved clear and stayed just off the inside through the bend, widened command under urging upper stretch, began to tire inside the last furlong but kept control under steady urging. SPEEDY CARACAL prominent toward the outside, was four then five wide through the bend, gained second into the lane, weaved slightly in and out as he made his bid and was too late. SILVER CHUNKUS without early speed from inside, swung out on the turn, came four wide into the lane, altered out when his path was taken midstretch, altered out further to stay clear of SPEEDY CARACAL in the late going and narrowly missed second. SILENT PURPOSE chased from inside, fanned three wide leaving the turn, fought for second upper stretch, then gradually lugged in as he weakened late. DATS DEE broke inward, bumping QUINTON'S BULL, backed up just off the inside on the turn, altered outside SILENT PURPOSE inside the final furlong and was getting to that one in the waning yards. GO BLAKERS GO hesitated then made a small leap from the gate, lost ground five wide leaving the turn then steadily improved position in the stretch without threatening. ATOMIC ECHO pressed from inside, following DANCING GHOST into the bend, drifted out leaving the turn and continued to give way. APACHE SPRINGS void of speed, was just off the inside taking the bend then had to alter his path twice to progress in the lane. GABE prominent between horses, saved ground taking the turn and flattened out for the drive. MY HOLY ROLLER pressed the early speed from outside, was forced out leaving the bend, altered in for a clear path upper stretch and steadily faded between foes. V I FREDERIKSTEAD dwelt badly at the break, raced wide throughout and showed little. QUINTON'S BULL

bumped at the start, chased from between rivals, gave way into the bend, soon took the rail and continued to retreat. There was a stewards' inquiry into V I FREDERIKSTEAD'S start but no action taken after their review.
