Footnotes

FUNNYOUSHOULDASK broke alertly, was rated on the front end from outside, moved ahead from path three on the turn, floated out some entering the lane, responded to hand urging upper stretch and steadily opened up. DEVON'S SPIRIT rushed up to vie for the early lead between rivals, did not keep up on the turn, gained the rail nearing the quarter pole, gave futile chase through the lane but proved easily second best. AMBERS PRIDE settled outside, lost ground as she improved position four to six wide through the bend and gained third late. JENGONEBY broke slowly and inward, was hustled along and taken toward the outside, three wide leaving the turn, angled in some upper stretch, progressed to the eighth pole then began to level off. DESERT TAP a step slow at the break, rushed up between horses, went for the lead four wide on the turn, was no match for the top pair when sent down for the drive and gradually wore down inside the final furlong. CONTESSA DEL NORTE also broke inward, was prominent between rivals, failed to keep up nearing the turn, swung out to path five for the stretch run and had little left. PLEASE N TERAS chased from between horses, lost ground widest through the bend and had no stretch bid. HIGHSPEED RESCUE void of speed, squeezed through along the rail leaving the bend, advanced to midstretch, began to yield and her rider lost her whip inside the final sixteenth. ELVIRA WHO was away slowly as well, quickly recovered to help prompt the pace from inside, could not keep up on the turn, floated out some leaving the bend and steadily gave way.
