KHAM BEAU pressed the pace three wide, took over nearing the quarter and was ridden out through the stretch. SANDY SAGE tracked the early pace, bid three wide into the lane, could not pressure the winner but proved easily second best. LITBIT RECKLESS helped force the pace from between horses, was no match for the winner on the turn but continued on well in the drive to save the show. DAYVONNA EXPRESS angled four wide into the stretch but raced evenly late. MAHALIE set the early pace from near the rail but tired in the stretch. GLITTERINGPROSPECT passed tiring rivals from off the rail. RUN MORE PECOS chased the pace from five wide only to tire in the drive. WELL BRIEFED showed little inside. VISION OF HOPE gave way in a wide trip. SHESARIDER refused. A steward's inquiry into the break revealed no mishap.
