Footnotes

DEL CONTE shared the lead briefly between horses, was taken back some, angled out three wide going to the bend, in path four on the turn, angled in some upper stretch while making his bid, was all out and got up in time. RED PETE was angled in midway on the backstretch, advanced just off the inside on the turn, went for the lead along the rail in the stretch, had the advantage with a sixteenth to go but did not have enough in the waning yards. HARALDO (CHI) settled off the inside, picked up his pace from path three on the turn, swung out five wide for room into the stretch, steadily closed the gap and caught MR. GOLDEN RULER for third near the wire. MR. GOLDEN RULER dueled for the lead outside AWESOME LAUNCH, was carried out some by the latter on the bend, angled in entering the lane, moved in to battle for the lead from path two upper stretch but gradually wore down the final sixteenth. FIERY TRIPPI widest throughout, found best stride too late. AWESOME LAUNCH displayed early speed from just off the rail, drifted out some on the turn, was corrected leaving the bend but slowly wore down and weaved out and back in deep stretch.
