Footnotes

SPICIE FORTUNE rated toward the outside, angled in nearing the turn, progressed two wide, swung out looking for room leaving the bend, came six wide into the stretch, gained a narrow advantage nearing the sixteenth marker and held off JANNA GAL. The latter dwelt at the start, spotting the rest a couple lengths, was hustled along, angled in to be just off the inside through the turn, altered out to three wide midstretch, battled for the lead the final sixteenth but could not get past SPICIE FORTUNE. EL OF RUCKUS in midpack early between horses, lost position three wide on the turn, lost her path to JANNA GAL midstretch and weaved out, then in some, trying to keep a clear path the final furlong as she rallied. JIVIN JACKIE bumped and forced out at the start, quickly moved up between horses, swung out five wide for a clear path into the turn, lacked the needed stretch kick, was forced out behind SPICIE FORTUNE nearing the sixteenth marker, altered out further and finished evenly. CUTIE MILLER pressed the early speed from just outside, went for the lead on the turn, was clear leaving the bend, all out just off the inside through the stretch but did not have enough left inside the last eighth. DESERT FLAG in the second flight from outside, took the bend four wide, began to wear down between rivals in the lane and drifted out some near the sixteenth marker. ICED chased while just outside EL OF RUCKUS on the backstretch, was four wide into the turn, lost considerable ground fanning to the middle of the track for the stretch run, could not make up ground but passed a couple tired ones. OH LADY WHO broke outward, bumping TAYLOR'S FOLLY, stayed close to the inside, had the rail into the lane, was steadied behind the fading SPANISH CHARMER nearing the eighth pole, altered out two wide with a furlong left and had no late bid. SPANISH CHARMER set the pace from between rivals, was just off the rail on the turn, could not stay with CUTIE MILLER leaving the bend, took the rail entering the stretch and gradually faded. STEP BY STEP unruly behind the gate, was soon far back, stayed well off the inside taking the

turn, angled in upper stretch, lacked a rally and was angled out for a clear path in the waning yards. TAYLOR'S FOLLY bumped and forced into JIVIN JACKIE at the break, quickly recovered to help prompt the pace from inside, gave way along the rail leaving the turn, was unresponsive upper stretch, eased the last furlong and walked off.
