**Footnotes**

WHOLELOTTAENERGY advanced outside to share the lead before finishing the first furlong and a half, gained a slight advantage three wide on the turn, was clear inside the final sixteenth and held sway under a mild drive. HUNTER MILL stumbled then bobbled again when bumped just after the break, bumped with JUMP WEST at that point, advanced between rivals, waited for room just off the inside entering the bend, swung out four wide for a clear path into the lane, was all out and slowly gaining on WHOLELOTTAENERGY. GET BACK MAN progressed along or just off the inside, squeezed through along the rail into the stretch, challenged WHOLELOTTAENERGY upper stretch but hung in the late going. JUMP WEST bumped just after the break, was an early contender toward the outside, failed to keep up three wide on the turn, fanned out behind HUNTER MILL entering the lane and only improved position without threatening. TEARNUPTHUNDER raced in contention from outside on the backstretch, backed up widest through the bend and only passed a couple tired ones from outside in the stretch. MIGHTY TO SAVE displayed early speed just off the rail then flattened out for the drive. RONTONAMO broke inward, bumping HUNTER MILL, contested the pace just outside MIGHTY TO SAVE, could not keep up two wide on the bend, lugged in and swiped the rail at the head of the lane, was checked and steadily faded as he tried to lug again.
