Footnotes

GHOSTLY BEACH crowded briefly after entering the main track, vied for the lead between horses, took the turn three wide, lugged in some upper stretch, was all out and edged ahead in the late going. COLORS OF POMPEII broke outward, press the pacesetters from outside, went for the lead four wide on the turn, battled gamely through the lane but had to settle for second best. DESERT AVENUE in contention early toward the outside, was three wide on the bend, swung out to path five for the stretch run, took over third upper stretch and gradually pulled away for that position without closing the gap on the top pair. FINISHRICH ON TIME pressed from inside, fanned out to path three looking for room into the lane, began to wear down and lugged in late. KISS ME SLEW displayed early speed just off or along the rail but flattened out for the drive. LIKE THE WIND drifted out briefly as she contested the pace shortly after entering the main track, was corrected, continued to vie for the lead between rivals but wore down two wide leaving the turn. Q T PIE broke in the air, was just off the inside entering the bend, floated out leaving the turn and bore in with a sixteenth left.
