Footnotes

PRINCE CARSON shared the early lead between horses, two wide through the bend, drew away when asked and was kept to task to the waning yards. SILK CREEK contested the pace just off the rail, no match for PRINCE CARSON when set down for the drive and could only just hold second late under steady handling. GOTTA SECRET was forwardly placed outside, three wide through the turn then lacked the needed stretch bid. SYDACIOUS void of speed, was three to five wide on the turn, lodged a bid into the lane but could only make up minor ground the final furlong. PAY THE VIG in contention early, saved ground through the bend, failed to rally in the stretch and angled outside SILK CREEK late. GALLANT BRAVE was taken inside midway on the backstretch, swung out six wide for the drive and passed tired ones. UNCLE MILEDGE hesitated at the break, showed no speed just off the rail, saved ground on the turn, lacked a stretch bid and was also angled out in the waning yards. KISS OF MONEY was a factor while toward the outside on the backstretch, began to fade four wide into the stretch, started to drift out some as SYDACIOUS came close inside the eighth pole, was steadied then continued to give way. HESADYNAMITELOOKER displayed early speed just off the rail but faltered entering the lane.
