TANGO TYLER bumped with SPY MASK at the break, was kept close from outside, commenced his bid five wide on the turn, lugged in some under a right whip into the stretch, soon gained the lead then steadily lengthened command under a drive the final eighth. H. E.'S FAST settled inside, was soon far back, was roused near the half mile pole, swung out to path seven entering the lane, moved out further midstretch, tried to drift out several times but caught BOSQUE MEETING for second in the waning yards. BOSQUE MEETING was sent to get the early lead, showed the way from paths two or three, could not stay with TANGO TYLER in the stretch and slowly wore down the final sixteenth. SPY MASK bumped at the start, was without early foot, progressed between horses on the turn, fanned out for a clear path leaving the bend, drifted out some further into the lane and gradually improved position. THATSNOLIE in contention toward the outside on the backstretch, angled in two wide taking the turn, bumped with DIXIE BANDJO at the head of the lane, battled for third and altered his path out then back in looking for room deep stretch. DIXIE BANDJO forced in some midway on the backstretch, altered out nearing the half mile marker, gained the rail into the bend, bumped with THATSNOLIE at the top of the stretch, fought for third but did not have enough left the last sixteenth. LATENITE COWBOY pressed the early speed from just outside, three wide through the turn, angled out some for a clear path midstretch but slowly wore down. SANTIAGO'S MAGIC also prominent between horses early, was four wide on the turn, checked briefly when his path was taken at the top of the stretch, altered out some and also did not have enough left for the drive. TUPAY gradually backed up while just off the inside, floated out some

into the stretch and was empty. MCKENNA BOY without speed from outside, began to pull up on the turn and was vanned off in distress.
