Footnotes

VOWSMAKEMEBLUSH broke alertly, shared the lead from between horses, began to move ahead when asked two wide leaving the bend, was clear upper stretch and held off IDEAL MISS under steady handling. IDEAL MISS was boxed in behind the early speed, got through three wide leaving the turn, moved clear for second upper stretch, could not close the gap on the winner but proved easily best of the rest. MARTHA'S BID raced in contention from outside, lost ground four wide on the turn, angled in some as well for the drive and could only pull clear for third late. WORLD GENIUS pressed the pacesetters in hand on the backstretch, three and four wide taking the bend, battled for third in the lane but did not have enough left deep stretch. THE HALO KID soon trailed from outside, angled in entering the turn, lacked a significant stretch response and had to alter out three wide inside the last eighth. RUNAWAYSLEW a bit slow at the break, rushed up inside to contest the pace but flattened out for the drive. SHESATERA a factor between horses on the backstretch, could not keep up into the bend, swung out widest on the turn and had little left.
