Footnotes

HIGH STAKES SILVER tracked the early leaders saving ground, angled out four wide near the five sixteenths, vied at the top of the stretch, was full of run and kicked clear. FAIR MARKET VALUE was unhurried early racing three wide, sustained a bid in the stretch, lacked room at the eighth pole then altered inward and gained the place. CANTALLBECHIEFS was off slow early, rallied four wide to duel at the top of the stretch, edged clear at the eighth pole, was challenged near the sixteenth pole and came up empty. HANK ACE forced the early pace from the outside, dueled into the second turn, battled to the eighth pole then flattened. POWERFUL PETE was outrun early saving ground and improved his position in the stretch. REAL COOL JAZZ dropped back early saving ground, drifted out six wide at the quarter pole and passed a tiring foe. SLEWRUN set the early pace saving ground and was finished early.
