KEAGAN'S WAY was unhurried early, rallied into the second turn, came through along the rail at the three sixteenths then surged clear nearing the wire. DESERT EXPLORER was allowed to settle early, went four wide to close in the stretch, duelled briefly then yielded. CITY MOON was forwardly placed early, went four wide, lost ground into the second turn then came back late for the show. SENOR PONDO was outrun early dropping back, went eight wide nearing the three sixteenths then showed some interest late. BAY VELVET was void of early speed, went off the rail and showed some effort late. CARMEN'S ROCKET raced mid pack, went five wide to place a brief bid then tired. PIE TOWN N M set the early pace along the inside, drifted out the rail near the three sixteenths then gave way. WORRY THIS forced the early pace from the outside and was finished early. SANTONIO SLEW raced mid pack saving ground, lacked room into the stretch, then altered outward and retreated.
