Footnotes

I GOT SILVER, allowed to settle, circled the field six wide into the lane, took aim at K J LUCKY SEVEN in deep stretch and took over nearing the wire under a strong hand ride. K J LUCKY SEVEN tracked the early leaders to the turn, bid four wide at the three-eighths, took the lead into the stretch and looked a sure winner a sixteenth out but began to shorten strides and was overtaken. GOLLYGOT stalked the pace from inside, angled five out for clear sailing into the stretch, loomed a brief threat but was no match though continued on well to hold down the show. GOOD TIMIN BROOK was near the rail on the turn, angled out for a rally between foes but backed out when the opening disappeared, continued on well but broke down after the race and was humanely destroyed. AMBERSENT improved position five wide. MISS EINSTEIN vied for the lead two wide between WAVEBAND and QUITE SPENDER, was jostled by those rivals in upper stretch and weakened from there. ONE FOXY LADY passed tired horses five wide. QUITE SPENDER pressed the pace three wide only to weaken in the stretch. JENIZARA (CHI) proved no threat off the rail. WAVEBAND had early speed inside but was on empty in the stretch. SUNNIE DO IT was never a factor. POTRANCA MUY FRIA gave futile chase to the frontrunners but soon tired badly.
