Footnotes

RED RULLAH rated on the front end between horses, moved ahead just off the inside on the turn, was asked at the top of the stretch then gradually opened up under mild hand urging. DESERT GAMBLE prominent between rivals on the backstretch, was just off the inside on the turn, fanned out to path four entering the lane, was blocked, altered in midstretch, steadily advanced and caught ON FIFTH STREET for second. ON FIFTH STREET pressed the early speed, was blocked behind RED RULLAH on the turn, got through outside that one leaving the bend, battled for second but was outfinished. JONES disputed the pace briefly from outside, was four wide into the lane, fought for second but did not have enough left in the waning yards. SURVIVORMAN in contention early from outside, made his bid five wide on the turn but leveled off through the stretch. TURBULENT TOUCH advanced from inside on the turn, altered out for a clear path after entering the final furlong and was forced out the last sixteenth. PALACIO well back early, was four and five wide taking the bend, lugged in nearing the eighth pole and had to alter inside KINGDELACROS deep stretch. KINGDELACROS displayed early speed inside, began to tire just off the rail into the stretch and drifted out in the late going. STORMIN BOLD dwelt at the break then failed to menace in a ground-saving trip. WILD SWEEP in tight quarters after the start, was checked, just off the inside on the turn, swung out to path four entering the lane, was steadied when PALACIO took his path upper stretch and had little to offer. J N LINCOLN COUNTY stayed in path three most of the way and showed little.
