Footnotes

TRADERS PRIDE kept close from outside, waited for room just off the inside on the turn, got through from path four entering the lane, was all out, gained a slight advantage deep stretch and slowly edged ahead. STORMIN BOMB contested the pace between horses from the beginning, came into the stretch from path three, fought gamely but did not have enough left nearing the wire. FLAME TO FAME weaved out and back in before finishing the first eighth, vied for the lead inside her rivals, came off the rail some leaving the turn and slowly wore down inside the last sixteenth. GOLDEN LANE an early factor just off the inside, failed to keep up on the turn, came back upper stretch, was gradually angled out for a clear path inside the final furlong but leveled off. PROPHEZISE prominent toward the outside, was three wide on the turn then drifted out leaving the bend and upper stretch as he flattened. SOARING DEVON quickly backed up from outside, stayed well off the rail taking the bend, angled out as PROPHEZISE came out upper stretch, moved inside that one in the late going but had little to offer. TEQUILA MOONRISE was a factor from inside on the backstretch but near the turn. DUE TO A MALFUNCTION, THE FIRST QUARTER MILE FRACTION WAS UNAVAILABLE.
