KINGS LEGACY was within striking distance early, rallied four wide in the stretch, wore down his rivals through the stretch and drew clear. DEVONAS PRIDE forced the early pace from the outside, lacked a gain in the stretch late but held the place. MAYBE TO FAST set the early pace racing off the inside, drifted three wide in the stretch and weakened. LOTA TALENT was unhurried early, went four wide and placed a mild bid. CROSS CHRIS RUN was allowed to settle early between foes and lacked a late response. EXPLOSIVE MINE was off slow early saving ground, angled out mid track in the stretch and placed a mild effort. ROYAL REVENGE was outrun early, raced wide throughout and failed to menace. HERBAL SLEW was forwardly placed early saving ground then retreated steadily in the stretch.
