Footnotes

KEEPER OF DREAMS advanced between horses, was swung outside MY LADY CORWYN leaving the turn, was carried out by that one into the stretch, took over near the eighth pole and was driven clear. MY LADY CORWYN prompted the early pace from outside, closed the gap four wide on the turn, drifted out into the stretch, chased KEEPER OF DREAMS through the lane and was clearly second best. HONEY'S RAINBOW was away somewhat slowly, checked lacking room, advanced between horses on the turn, was steadied behind AUTUMN MOONSHINE into the stretch, altered out, altered out again near the eighth pole and got up for third late. SHESGONECOUNTRY raced in contention early between horses, was swung out six wide into the stretch for a clear path, had no rally but improved her position. PRETTYASAPICTURE broke in stride, soon moved inside, set the pace for a half mile then began to tire. POSH EXCESS broke outward, bumped WILD JUNGLE, was soon in midpack toward the outside, lost ground six wide on the bend and advanced in the lane without threatening. LEIGH WELLS soon moved toward the inside, was checked along the rail lacking a clear path leaving the turn, altered outside PRETTYASAPICTURE and flattened out. AUTUMN MOONSHINE broke inward, was without speed, advanced three wide on the turn and lugged in the last eighth. ROYAL RELATIONS bumped at the start, had no speed, was five wide on the turn, altered out abruptly to avoid HONEY'S RAINBOW and had little left. JENNA'S GEM pressed PRETTYASAPICTURE early, angled outside that one on the turn, went for the lead but faltered between rivals in the lane.

WILD JUNGLE bumped at the start and forced into ROYAL RELATIONS, backed up between horses, moved inside on the turn and had nothing to offer for the drive. ARKANSAS DEE LITE soon trailed from well off the rail, also moved inside on the turn and was unresponsive.
