**Footnotes**

FAITHFUL BEAU stalked the pace three wide, was roused on the second turn, in close quarters between rivals as he went for the lead, was brushed as he took the advantage near the sixteenth marker but held sway with little asking. SAARMAN prominent four wide from the early going, gradually progressed, battled gamely through the lane, lugged in a bit near the sixteenth marker, brushed FAITHFUL BEAU, was corrected, did not have enough in the waning yards but moved clear for second. DEL MAR DRAMA lugged in some and bumped BEAU'S HALO shortly after the break, was soon clear and inside, challenged on the backstretch, shared the lead along the rail to inside the final furlong then slowly yielded. GOOD GUY moved up two wide to share the lead on the backstretch then also did not have enough left the last eighth. BEAU'S HALO bumped after the start, came into contention from outside on the backstretch, was three and four wide taking the second turn and ran evenly the last quarter mile. MINISTER PERFECT was a factor along or just off the rail to the lane then began to tire. NOAH BY STORM was steadied while in tight shortly after the break, took the inside entering the first bend, stayed along the rail the rest of the way and failed to menace. SUGARBUGA stayed off the inside throughout and showed little. THE GREAT STRAUSS steadily backed up from between horses, pulled up in distress midstretch and was vanned off.
