### Footnotes

TRAIN RIDER BLUES rated toward the outside, progressed between horses into the bend, split rivals three wide leaving the turn, caught in tight between LANE STORMER and QUICKLY at the head lane, bumped with the latter, gained a slight advantage, was all out the rest of the way and held on. LANE STORMER in the second flight, drifted out some entering the turn, was four wide leaving the bend, brushed with TRAIN RIDER BLUES at the top of the stretch, was angled out a bit after that, battled gamely the rest of the way but had to settle for second best. MY PICASSO showed first, was soon taken in hand and made his way to the outside, was carried out to path five on the bend, loomed seriously with a furlong left, proved no match for the top pair but pulled away for third. GRANNY'S SONG broke inward and a step slowly, was steadied behind traffic, soon well back, two wide on the turn, floated out some for the stretch run and passed tired ones. QUICKLY disputed the pace from outside, two wide taking the turn, was bumped at the top of the stretch, angled in some and flattened out the final furlong. BLAZING SUPERSTAR vied for the lead from inside but began to tire along the rail the last quarter mile. ONE BELL OF A BULL steadily faded in a ground-saving trip.
