MOSTLY DUST was the early leader and drew off to be the easy winner. GODZIA got off slow going four wide, circling horses to be second best. LOUIE'S BROTHER was mid pack going four wide, rallied at the three eighths pole and got up for show. MR. SPEEDWHEEL MAN was mid field on the rail, then angled out at the quarter pole and closed well. MAKENNA'S GOLD stalked the pace on the inside with an even effort. COSMIC SURFER forced the pace, then made an early bid, but hung late to be vanned off following race. ONE FINE JEWEL pressed the pace and retreated. DOUBLE RECESS trailed the field and passed a tiring rival. DEPUTRESS was near the back on the rail and never fired.
