Footnotes

LATENITE COWBOY set the early pace, drew clear in the first turn racing three wide, was well rated down the backstretch, held to nearing the eighth pole, then was headed by POPZ, dueled gamely to the wire and held. POPZ stalked the early leaders, went three wide down the backstretch, rallied nearing the quarter pole, came on even terms nearing the eighth pole, dueled to the wire with a game try but was out nodded. TUFF REVIEW was unhurried early, closed the gap into the second turn, then placed a bid along the rail to contend with the leaders in deep stretch and flattened in the final strides. KEY TO THE BAND was allowed to settle early, lost ground down the backstretch and was only able to improve his position in the stretch. GHOSTLY FLY was outrun early racing four wide and lacked a closing response. WILDINTHEWILDWEST was void of early speed, split foes down the backstretch placing a brief bid then gave way. GOLD GULCH chased the early leader from the outside and dropped out after a half.
