Footnotes

DON CISCO was near the back, making a steady gain, angled out at the quarter pole, closed willingly down the lane. SILVER NITE R F got away alertly and was in contention early, then made a bid but got edged at the wire. NATIVE MINISTER pressed the pace, made a bid and dueled in the stretch to be a game third. MINERS SHINER trailed the field early going wide throughout, then rallied on the outside going seven wide. FULL CUT was in the middle of the pack, three wide and lacked the needed late response. DOMS TRICK was mid field, five wide with a mild bid. FRED'S HENNESSY made the lead and gave way at the eighth pole. RUN LITTLE RED was five to six wide and ran evenly. MR ERIC stalked the pace, three wide and faded at the quarter pole. DR WILDCARD was mid pack on the inside and retreated. DESERT FREEZE had no speed with a rail trip and never fired.
