PLUM FAST was forwardly placed early, then angled out in the turn and closed willingly in the stretch drive. FAST ISTINTAJ had no early speed, angled out at the three eighths and went five wide making a bid on the way outside for second. DANGEROUS HEART was mid pack going two wide, then rallied between horses to get up for show. GROOVY GHOULIE trailed the field early, angled out going four wide and offered a mild bid late. SAINT STREET pressed the pace, three wide, made a bid in the turn but gave way at the sixteenth pole. GOOD NITE GRACE was hustled to the lead and retreated at the eighth pole. MONEYINPARENTHESSES had a rail trip from the middle of the pack but lacked the needed late response. XCESSIVE LEAD was pulled up and vanned off at the quarter pole.
