Footnotes

VINNY V. was the early leader, getting headed at the five sixteenth by STRIKE A SPIDER, then came back and rallied down the lane, drawing off. THREE SLEWS was mid field, angled out going four wide, rallied between horses and picked up second. AWESOME LAUNCH was on the inside, stalking the pace, made a mild bid late and got up for show. INDIAN WEAVER was near the back on the rail, angled out and offered a mild rally. STRIKE A SPIDER pressed the pace, made an early bid on the turn, taking a brief lead, then gave way at the quarter pole. BROTHER WARBUCKS was mid pack going four to five wide and lacked the needed late response. AUDIENCE was forwardly placed early going three wide, made a mild bid on the turn and faded in the stretch. WHOS LAZY was four wide and never fired. CARPINTERO trailed the field and was no factor.
