YET ANOTHERNATALIE mowed down BELLE OF BROADWAY three wide midway of the turn and quickly took over, drawing away with only hand encouragement. KARROO saved ground on the turn and then altered out for the drive for a bid that gained second money. SATINE had no speed but began to advance from inside on the turn, then angled two wide for the stretch and gained the place but was too late for the show. EAT A BUG was three wide between rivals on the turn and improved position down the stretch. MIST OF THE EMPIRE had no speed but swung to the far outside for the drive and passed some tired ones. BELLE OF BROADWAY zipped right to the lead and angled in to the two path but was no match for the winner on the turn, then tired in the stretch. BELLEVIEW LADY gave chase from four wide and then tired down the lane. SARAH BAIN came up empty five wide.
