Footnotes

KINGS LEGACY was sent up to get the lead from inside, under steady urging through the stretch and held off QUINTON'S FIRST. QUINTON'S FIRST showed first, stalked the early speed from outside, progressed four wide through the turn, was all out in the stretch, loomed the last sixteenth, did not have enough in the waning yards but proved easily second best. BUCKSTER prominent between horses from the beginning, went for the lead three wide on the bend, gave futile chase to the top pair in the stretch, battled to keep third and lasted. GHOST SMASHER caught in tight quarters between horses nearing the end of the first quarter mile, was shuffled back going to the bend, four and five wide through the turn, lacked the needed stretch bid but narrowly missed for third. JACKPOT WHO bumped and forced into STORM'N RULER at the break, jostled with the latter leaving the chute, altered out some midway on the backstretch, lost ground five and six wide taking the bend then steadily improved position in the lane. BOLD COTORO broke inward, bumping JACKPOT WHO, advanced in tight quarters, brushed with GHOST SMASHER near the half mile marker then jostled briefly with CAPTAIN JAZZ, got through two wide just after that, still threatened with a quarter mile left, failed to keep up entering the stretch, moved to the rail shortly after that and slowly yielded. STORM'N

RULER bumped with CAPTAIN JAZZ at the start, jostled about just after that, checked leaving the chute, improved position three wide on the turn, lost considerable ground floating out to path eight entering the stretch, progressed to the final furlong then leveled off. KING'S JOURNEY a step slow at the break, steadily advanced along the rail, came off the inside some for the stretch run and flattened out. CARACAL CASH soon backed up from outside, stayed wide through the bend and lacked a significant late bid. CAPTAIN JAZZ bumped with STORM'N RULER at the start, was an early contender just off the inside, bumped then steadied behind traffic nearing the half mile marker, backed up on the turn, was three wide entering the lane and had little to offer. GRANT'S GHOST displayed early speed between horses but faded three wide on the turn. YONDERLY void of speed between rivals, stayed well off the inside taking the bend and was empty the last quarter mile.
