Footnotes

OMER'S SURE SHOT broke alertly, set the pace off the inside, was challenged from inside on the second turn, battled through the lane and shook off RAMPAGING KING inside the final sixteenth. RAMPAGING KING altered inside on the backstretch, went for the lead along the rail on the second turn, fought through the stretch but did not have enough left in the waning yards. OCEAN JOE forward placed outside from the beginning, was four wide through the second bend, drifted out some upper stretch under left-handed pressure, corrected the final eighth, closed well and proved easily best of the rest. TY'S PACHE without early foot from inside, angled out nearing the second bend, was just off the rail into that turn, swung five wide for the stretch run and passed some tired ones. SHAKEN THE CAGE pressed three wide for six furlongs then began to flatten. INIQUITOUS KID a step slow at the break, was taken off the inside on the backstretch, stayed well off the inside taking the second turn and lacked a stretch bid. BOOGER BOO a brief contender, failed to keep up on the backstretch, made up ground along the inside on the second turn, fanned out to path four into the lane and steadily gave way.
