Footnotes

LISASFINISHLINE rated on the front end between rivals, was in path three entering the stretch, gained a narrow advantage, was all out and held off MGBA KISSIN SILVER. MGBA KISSIN SILVER showed first, was prominent outside LISASFINISHLINE from the early going, floated out some entering the stretch, battled gamely but did not have enough through the waning yards. INIQUITOUS KID forwardly placed just behind SKIPPER DO, was blocked behind that one at the top of the stretch, altered in nearing the eighth pole, loomed for the lead but could only just maintain his position late. MAGNIFICENT STORM hesitated at the start, gradually progressed from outside, lost ground six wide into the lane, gradually closed the gap and bested the rest. SKIPPER DO contested the pace from inside, floated out a bit on the second turn then gradually backed up while trying to drift out in the stretch. QUINTON'S FIRST raced in contention toward the outside, bid two wide on the second turn, fanned out to path four entering the stretch and wore down the final furlong. SOME KIND OF LUCK was an early factor just inside QUINTON'S FIRST, swung out behind that one for the stretch run and also faded in the late going. SLICKUNO broke inward, was soon well back and inside, came off the rail into the second bend and was empty through the lane.
