**Footnotes**

VESTAL VIRGIN brushed with DRIVING MISS DOM at the start, was rated on the front end between rivals, moved ahead when let out just off the rail on the turn, drifted out to path four into the stretch, responded to urging, drew off and was under a drive until inside the last sixteenth. COLORS OF POMPEII altered in early trying to keep a clear path, advanced four then five wide through the turn, fought for second through the lane and narrowly held on. DESERT AVENUE in contention not far off the inside on the backstretch, jostled briefly with A PENNY LANE while just off the rail when caught in tight quarters midway on the turn, was forced in upper stretch, fought for second the last eighth but missed in a game effort. DRIVING MISS DOM brushed with VESTAL VIRGIN at the break, angled in early, swung out some on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and steadily progressed between rivals. A PENNY LANE raced with DESERT AVENUE from just outside, jostled briefly with that one midway on the turn, lost ground fanning to path six entering the stretch, tried to veer out under left-handed pressure inside the final furlong, was corrected and gradually advanced. ON STRIDE shared the early lead from outside, could not stay with VESTAL VIRGIN while three wide leaving the turn, angled in some upper stretch and weakened in the late going. D CAT'S TRIP caught in crowding shortly after the start, gradually moved toward the outside, was widest taking the turn and wore down for the drive. DIVIDEND TIME made a small leap from the gate, advanced inside to help prompt the pace, began to tire entering the lane, was angled out midstretch for a clear path and continued to fade. GHOSTLY LADY shuffled back and checked off heels shortly after the start, saved ground through the turn, was angled out midstretch and had no late bid.
