Footnotes

RINGING BERNIE in hand from outside, was let out from path three leaving the turn, floated out some entering the stretch, gained the advantage approaching the eighth pole then gradually moved ahead under a mild drive inside the last furlong. SMART CITY DOC set a pressured pace between rivals, stayed just off the inside through the bend, was all out in the lane but did not have enough left deep stretch. APOLLEAN hustled along from between horses, followed RINGING BERNIE through the turn, angled outside that one near the furlong marker, drifted out some after that, held a straight path the final sixteenth and came up short. FANNY CHENAL prominent inside, failed to keep up on the turn, was gradually altered out through the lane and could only make up minor ground late. PERFECT FINISH away slowly, showed no speed from inside, was just off the rail on the turn, floated out some into the stretch, closed the gap some going to the eighth pole then finished evenly. FREQUENT FAME a step slow at the break, trailed from outside, took the rail on the turn and had no stretch bid.
